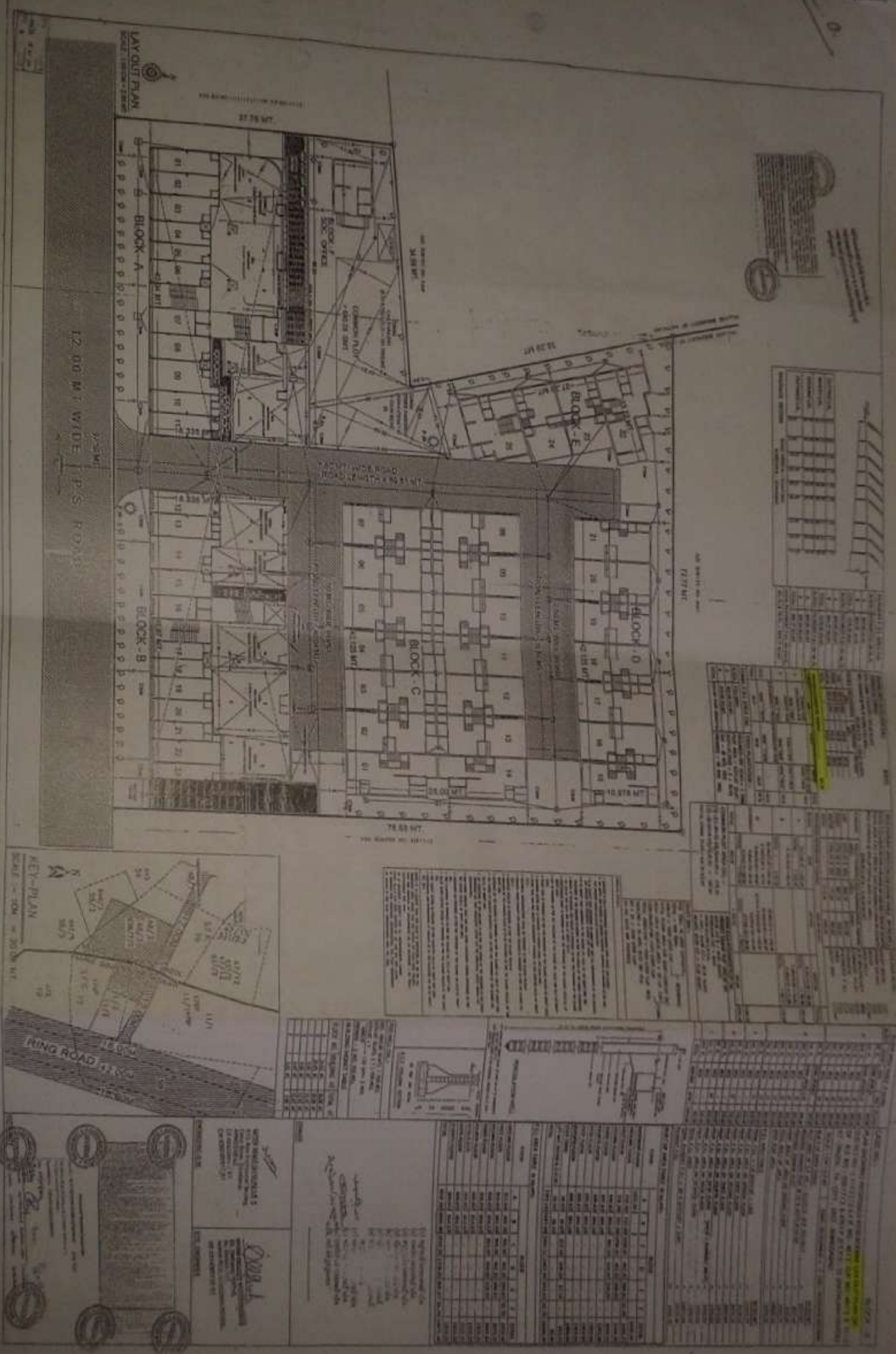




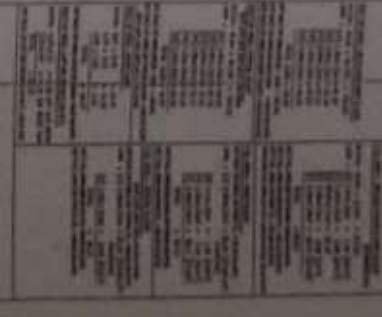
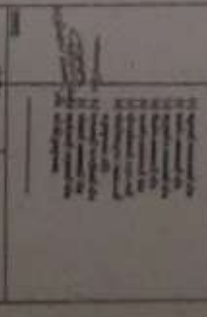
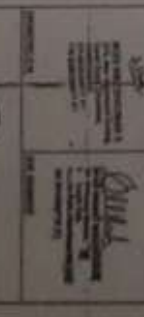
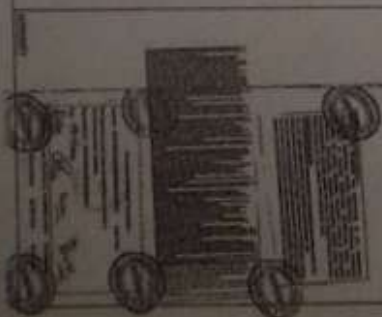
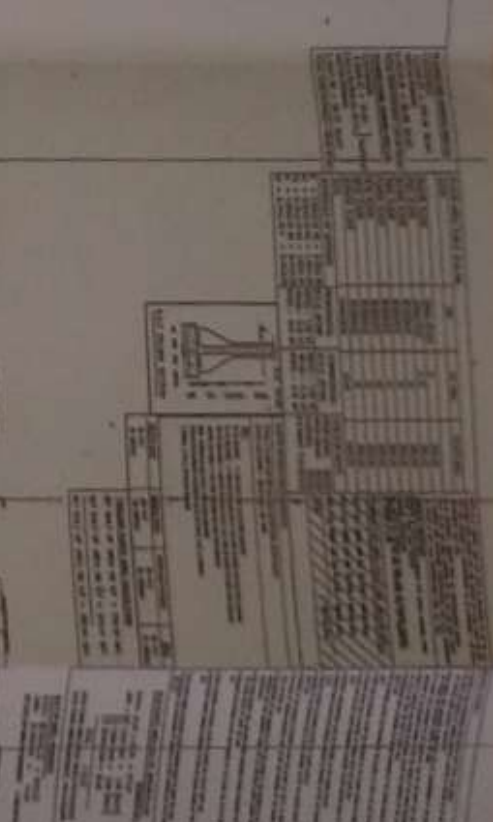
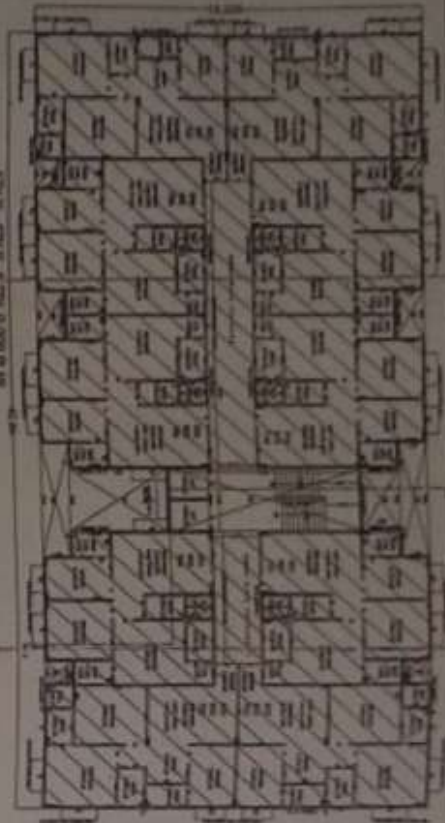
GROUND FLOOR PLAN

2ND FLOOR PLAN

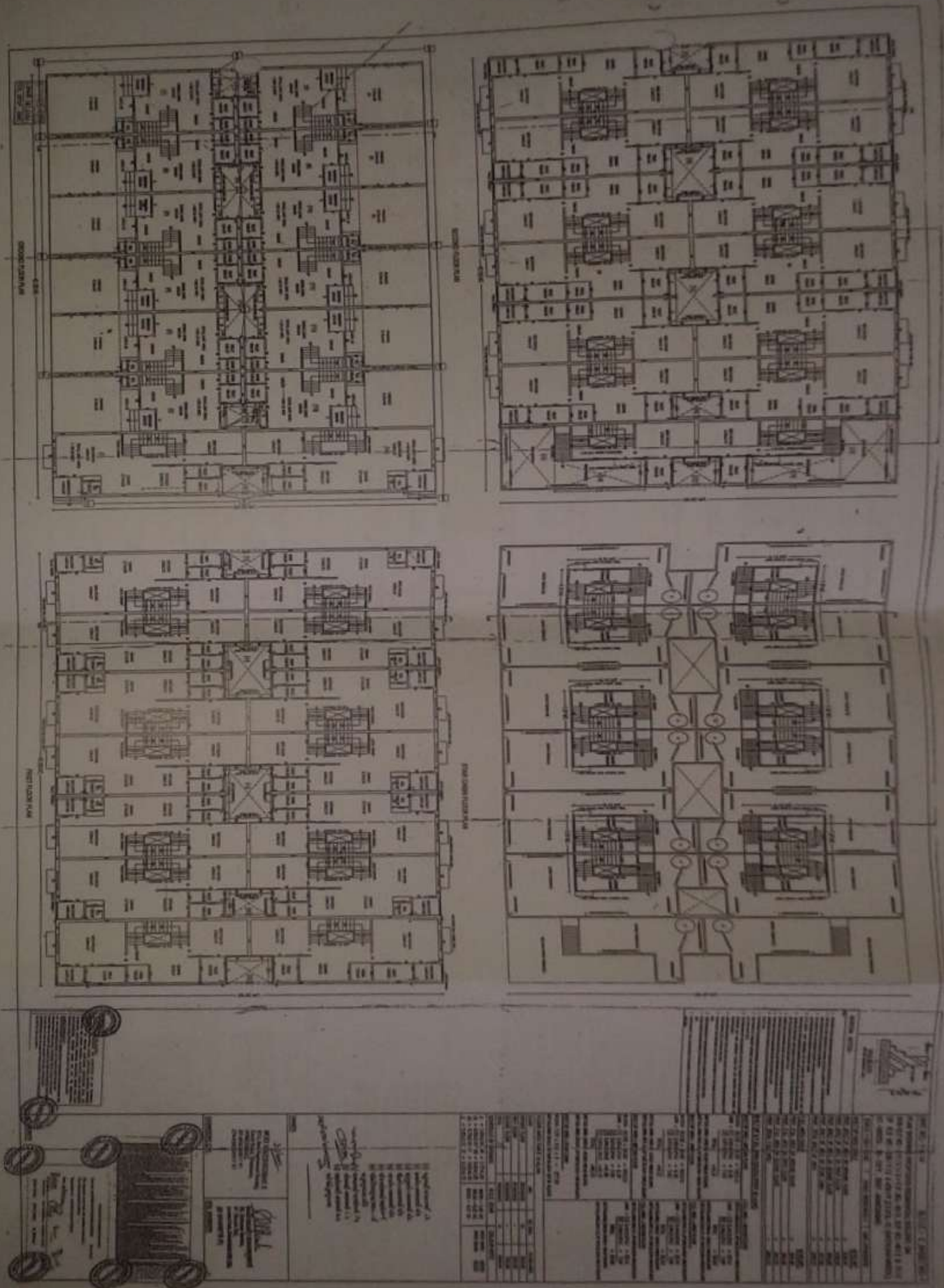
3RD, 4TH & 5TH FLOOR PLAN

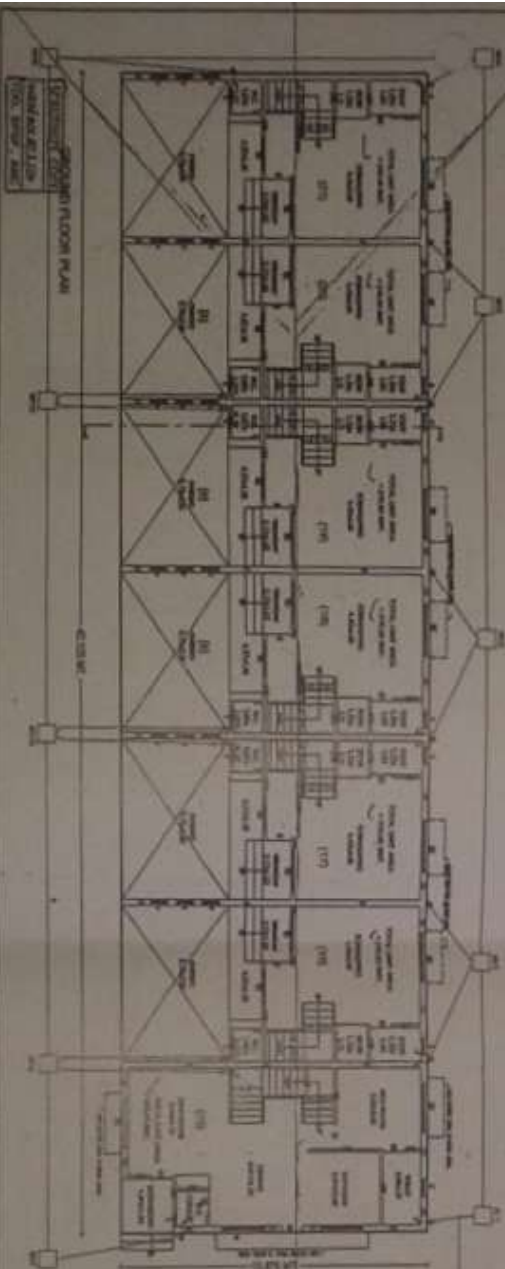
FIRST FLOOR PLAN

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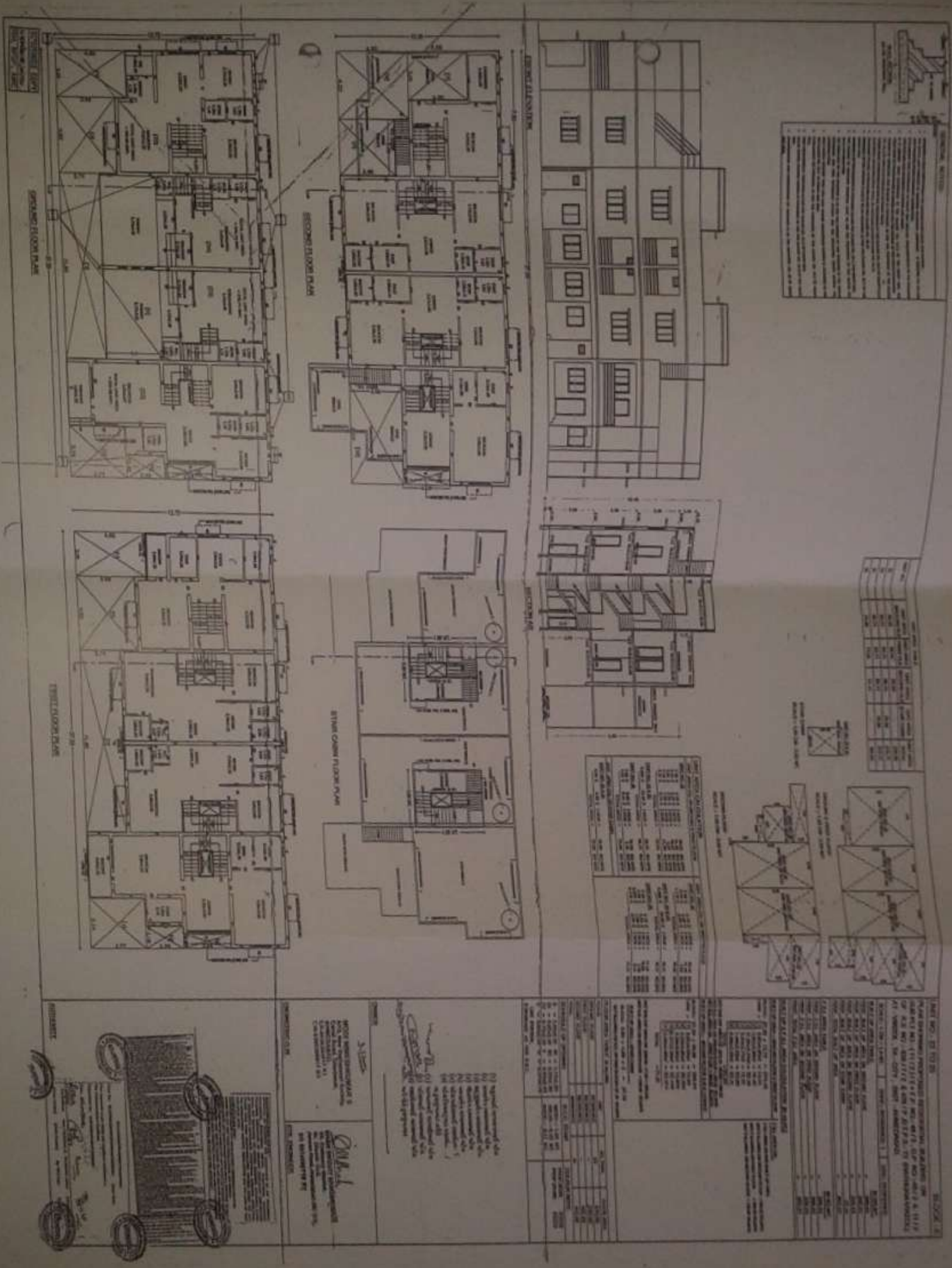

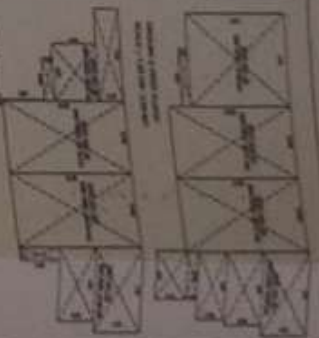
