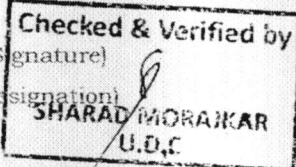

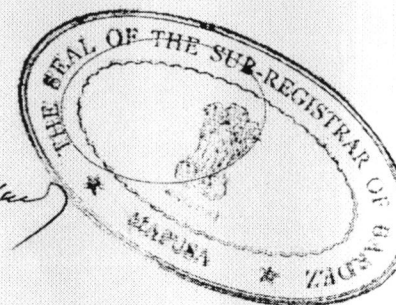
Note -
