My last will and testament.

1. My humble prestrations to the Almighty for all the mercies he has shown to me and my family.
2. My father left no immoveable properties and what cash we had was divided between me and my two deceased brothers several years ago.
3. After the demise of my father in 1890, when I was a boy of only about 17 years, the burden of the family consisting of my mother, my five sisters and my 2 brothers fell on me. What with the Education and marriages of my children, I was hardly able to save anything except the house noted in the Schedule below, which I purchased from my Government Insurance amount, preterred of the fact that my children are my valued assets
4. I have nominated my three surviving daughters and my wife to my whole life policies and they will in due course get each about one thousand Rupees, which they will enjoy absolutely as their streedhan.
5. I have transferred my petty shares as a mere token to the joint names of my wife and each of my sons, so that they will get them after the lifetime of my wife. Some shares in the joint names of myself and ~~some~~ of my sons go to them as they were purchased from amounts received by them.
6. As regards the scheduled house, my wife will have a life Estate in it and after ~~her~~ her lifetime, it will go to my six sons each getting a $\frac{1}{6}$ th share. If one ^{more of} or ~~my~~ sons wish to retain the house and live in it, it is open to them to do so by the consent of the rest and by fixing a fair value to it and giving them their shares. If they do not come to such an agreement, they may of course sell it to the best price and divide the sale proceeds equally. The above may be done even during the lifetime of my wife (B.R. Mahalakshamma) if she should

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consent and if need be after making suitable arrangements for her residence.

7. The household moveables in the house are not worth mentioning and may be disposed of by my wife at her discretion.

8. SCHEDULE. House bearing municipal door No.64/79 in the 1st Main Road in Seshadripuram, Bangalore city (including conservancy lane lately purchased by me from the municipality) bounded on the north by Mr. D.Raja Reddy's compound wall, on the East by the wire fencing put by me and the U-shaped stone drain of the municipality on the South by the compound wall of the house of Messrs B.K.Subbaiah & Sons and on the West by the I Main Road

9. In the Bangalore Transportation Co., I own 10 ordinary shares of 10 Rs. each (no.52) and 3 ordinary shares (No.878) These are made out in the joint names of myself and my Eldest son B.R.Narasimhaengar. They will automatically go to ^{him} ~~hand~~ after my life time. I own 6 other shares (No.1578) which are in my name alone. I hereby bequeath these shares also to him, in view of his being unemployed.

10. I have transferred my Mysore Government 5% shares to the joint names of myself and my wife B.R.Mahalakshamma ^{Vij} nos. 003894, 003895 and 003896 of 1000 Rs. Of these the 2nd one is kept in the Mysore Bank as Security for any overdraft that we may take from our joint account from the Bank, my wife will automatically get the Bonds after my lifetime and she may use them for her necessary and urgent expenses. If any of the bonds are left unspent before her demise, they will go to my 6 sons in equal shares.

11. I have every hope that ^{my} ~~sons~~ will continue to be loving and helpful to each other as they have hitherto been and will do their best to keep their loving mother in comfort and I need not advise them in the matter. My best wishes to one and all

The above will take effect after my demise.

CODICIL No. 3 dated 14th September 1957.
To my Registered will.

6. B.R.Narasimha Iyengar

The person exercising the option of purchase will give the value of Rs.5000/- ~~to each of the~~ to each of the others and obtain receipt from them. The option will be exercised within a year of my death. They may extend this term by mutual agreement of all the brothers to a period of two years.
